



Bring your camera to school day!

Thursday, October 18th

Why? The Yearbook staff members need pictures of students (and teachers) smiling, eating, working and learning.

Details: When you arrive with your camera on Thursday, October 18th, you will present this signed form to the tables in the main lobby to receive a photo pass that must be worn **all day**. The school is **NOT** to be held responsible for your camera. We encourage students to have their camera with them at all times. Be sure it is labeled clearly with your name and home phone number.

Throughout the day, take pictures of your classmates, teachers, and friends. BUT the Yearbook needs photos of students learning/working, teachers teaching, lunchroom staff serving, administrators administering, counselors counseling, janitors cleaning, coaches coaching, librarians checking out books, etc. Be sure to ask your teacher or WHOEVER is in charge of the room if it is okay for you to take some shots. Any faculty member who feels the photo taking is disruptive; they can collect your camera and send it to the office to be held until the end of the day.

****Burn a CD** of your photos and turn in to the box in the main office marked **YEARBOOK PHOTOS** by the following Thursday, October 25th. Remember these photos are for the Yearbook and will not be published on the web site or in any other public forum.
